### **TREETOPS ADVENTURE PARK NETS TOURISM GRANT WIN**

A sky-high maze of tree houses connected by nets and slides will be the newest tourist attraction on the Central Coast following a NSW Government grant win by the TreeTops Adventure Park.

Member of the Legislative Council, The Hon Taylor Martin MLC said the Park will receive \$149,000 from the Regional Tourism Fund, which is managed by the NSW Government's tourism and major events agency, Destination NSW.

"The TreeTops Adventure Park already provides a broad range of unique and exciting outdoor experiences for people of all ages and abilities so I am delighted that this NSW Government funding will allow them to add to their existing tourism offering," Mr Martin said.

"The Central Coast is known for its natural beauty and adventure activities and the Treetops Adventure Park is perfect for children and the young at heart alike," he said.

"The proposed design of the net park preserves the natural environment. Each treehouse is built around the existing tree structure and the nets are cut to size and installed around them."

Minister for Tourism and Major Events Adam Marshall congratulated TreeTops Adventure Park on their successful application which will attract more visitors to the area.

"The Regional Tourism Fund is part of our strategy to boost tourism right across the State and aims to increase visitation to our wonderful regions such as the Central Coast which in turn, supports the local economy and jobs," Mr Marshall said.

"Right across our regions we're working hard to make it easier for event proponents, tour operators, hoteliers, and visitor attractions to access vital grants to get their initiatives off the ground and to get tourism booming. We look forward to welcoming more travelers to the Central Coast region as a result of this funding boost."

The Regional Tourism Fund is part of the NSW Government's record funding
